The Triton Underground Scholars program is working to build a prison-to-university pipeline by increasing the number of formerly incarcerated people pursuing higher education at UC San Diego. We do this by supporting the development of similar programs at other colleges and by advocating for policies that directly affect justice-impacted individuals. We work with admissions professionals, deans, and faculty on UC and community college campuses in the San Diego region to eliminate barriers to higher education faced by criminal justice-impacted students.

<u>Fresh Start: Comprehensive Criminal Record Relief Program</u> -A criminal record can make finding employment, obtaining housing, enrolling in and funding an education, and securing other civic opportunities very difficult. The good news is that there are options for you to move forward, even if you have made mistakes in the past.
